The **International Telematic University UNINETTUNO** was established by the Decree of 15 April 2005 by the Ministry of Education, University and Research and was born from the didactic model of the **NETTUNO Consortium**, a consortium of 41 Italian and 31 foreign public universities, and from the success of the European project **MedNet'U - Mediterranean Network of Universities**. Since 1992, hundreds of thousands of students have graduated at a distance via television and the Internet.

Today, some of these universities place at the disposal of UNINETTUNO physical facilities such as laboratories for research and didactic activities and classrooms for face-to-face exams.

UNINETTUNO is today the only Italian telematic university that has been positively evaluated by ANVUR - National Agency for the Evaluation of the University and Research System, with **prestigious lecturers and students coming from 170 countries worldwide**. A virtual space, but not only, for the global circulation of knowledge.

The University has always been based on a **forward-looking vision**, focused on continuous **innovation** and research, offering the **highest quality education** that is **accessible to everyone everywhere**. It focuses on an advanced psycho-pedagogical model that exploits the potential of available digital technologies and put the student at the centre of the educational process, integrating cognitive and connectionist theories, promoting active and dynamic learning. The Call

The aim is **to enrich the educational experience of international students, facilitate a deeper understanding of content** through linguistic and cultural affinity, and **promote an educational environment that is truly open to intercultural dialogue**.

Purpose of the Call

The International Telematic University UNINETTUNO invites expressions of interest from qualified scholars and professionals for potential collaboration as academic tutors (docenti tutor) within its Faculties and Degree Programs.

This is a non-binding call, issued for the sole purpose of creating a list of suitable candidates who may be contacted and considered, if and when the need arises, to carry out academic tutoring and support activities in the University's online learning environment.

Submission of an expression of interest does not constitute a formal application, nor does it imply any commitment on the part of UNINETTUNO to establish a contractual relationship. The inclusion in the list does not guarantee any assignment of duties or remuneration.

Tasks:

The academic tutors will be responsible for:

- Coordinating the teaching activities of the course according to the UNINETTUNO coordinator of the course
- Carrying out online tutoring activities on the UNINETTUNO platform
- Search, create and upload didactic materials in the digital library of the UNINETTUNO platform (linked to single lessons)
- Conduct interactive classrooms via UNINETTUNO Interactive Class Systems
- Monitor and control students' activities on the platform
- Collaborate in the research activities of the Faculty of reference

Modalities of conducting activities:

The tutoring activities will be carried out in English entirely remotely and on the UNINETTUNO platform, in accordance with the psycho-pedagogical model of distance learning developed by UNINETTUNO Rector Prof. Maria Amata Garito.



Eligibility:

Candidates should hold at least a Master's Degree or equivalent qualification in a relevant discipline. Prior experience in university-level teaching or tutoring, especially in online or blended environments, will be considered an asset.

The selection will be carried out by the Faculty Councils concerned.

How to express interest:

Interested candidates are invited to submit:

- A detailed CV
- A brief statement of interest (max 1 page)
- Any relevant teaching certifications or references

Interested candidates must fill in the application form (**Annex 1**).

Applicants may apply for one or more modules, or the whole thematic area.
