



Twenty-one students from Mediterranean countries receive training on climate change at UNINETTUNO



The first edition of the online training programme Reporting on Climate Change and Sustainable Development from UNINETTUNO ended last January.

Twenty-one students from nine Mediterranean countries completed the course Reporting on Climate Change and Sustainable Development in January 2021, offered through the online learning platform of the **International Telematic University UNINETTUNO**. Trainees participating in the course come from countries such as Egypt, Tunisia, Algeria, Jordan, Greece, Serbia, Romania, Bulgaria and Slovenia.

This multilingual programme, which was taught in English and Arabic, received funding from the European Investment Bank and the non-profit association **COPEAM**.

During this three-module course, students acquired knowledge related to climate change and sustainable development by watching 14 hours of video lessons and studying various bibliographic resources. Besides, they interacted to discuss the 13 open topics in the forum of the programme.
