Cooperation on research programs; teachers exchange; realization of a joint educational offer and launch of joint vocational training courses, the use of UNINETTUNO e-learning Platform and model: these are the main points of the agreement signed by the Italian Minister of Education, University and Research Stefania Giannini and the Moroccan Minister of Higher Education, Scientific Research and Executives' Training Lahcen Daoudi, and the Rector of UNINETTUNO Prof. Maria Amata Garito, and the Rector of Al Akhawayn University of Ifrane Driss Ouauicha.



UNINETTUNO's educational offer for students from Somalia

Thanks to an agreement signed with the Global University of Science of Galkayo, the first edition of the master's course in "Health Management" aimed at training the managerial and administrative staff of the Somali hospitals was launched on February 2nd.

50 somali students (50% females and 50% males) were selected by the local Minister of Education according with the admission criteria and have already started their online study session on UNINETTUNO e-learning platform. Somali students who don't have access to internet connection can access the brand-new-technological pole set in Galkayo with high speed internet connection and a satellite videoconference system for exams and study sessions. This distance teaching postgraduate programme will allow the workers of the Somali healthcare services to access – while remaining in their own country – an international-level higher education path, delivered in English by the best teachers of UNINETTUNO, expert in this field and coming from all over Europe.
